22 April, 2020, Hong Kong - Over the Influence is pleased to announce the first solo exhibition of Mark Nixon in Hong Kong, *MuchLoved*. The selection of 14 photographs from the series includes the famed teddy from the TV show “Mr Bean” along with a stuffed bear that belonged to a close friend of the musician Bono. Each photograph is accompanied by a descriptive paragraph sharing the story of the stuffed animal and their owner. *MuchLoved* will be on view from 22 May – 27 June 2020 from Tuesday – Saturday during the hours of 11 AM – 7 PM. In lieu of an opening reception the gallery will be open all day on Thursday 21 May 2020 from 11 AM – 7 PM.
